

County Commission

The County Commission directs the County Attorney to help with legal concerns for the commission, but the only control they have over other county officials is through the purse strings.










TELL THE STORY OVER AND OVER AGAIN

For people in government to make something a priority, they need to feel like they have to

- 1. Pressure from constituents
- 2. Pressure from the community
- 3. Repeated press on constant issue
 - a. Relationships with reporters
 - b. Making sure lawmakers see it and get asked about what they are going to do (or being told what they need to do)
- 4. Pressure in an election



What is recruitment?


