

Social Norms that Contribute to Sexual Violence: How did the bridge get broken?

Social Norms

- Rigid gender roles
- Aggression and Violence
- Abuse of power
- SV as a private problem
- Acceptance of violence as the norm
- Sex shaming and negativity

Change Strategies

- Challenging sexism by creating leadership opportunities for girls and women
- Promoting healthy communication
- Treating SV as a public concern
- Bystander Intervention
- Information about healthy sexuality



Get to know the Problem: How is the bridge broken?

- Identify the different dynamics that impact different types of sexual violence
- How many people are being impacted? How are they being impacted?
- How are different communities impacted





Protect Against the Problem: How do we repair the bridge?

- Improving safety in schools
- Changing policies
- Connect youth with safe, caring adults
- •Foster youth commitment to school and positive projects
- Teach young people skills to support healthy relationships
- Community connectedness
- Increase access to resources


No matter how much Fish 2 tries, it may never reach its full health potential due to its dirty water and cracked bowl.



Root Causes of Violence




Darker = what is typically seen, noticed, taken seriously

Lighter = what is typically unseen, hidden, not taken as seriously
